GENESIS EIR Cohort 2: Advancing Deep-Tech Innovations from Tier II & III of India

KIIF supports 4 startups through MeitY GENESIS with Funding Support under GENESIS (Entrepreneur-in-Residence)

Under the MeitY GENESIS – Entrepreneur-in-Residence (EIR) Program, Karnavati Innovation & Incubation Foundation (KIIF) supported four deep-tech startups selected through multiple screening rounds involving startups and student innovators from Tier II and Tier III regions. The cohort reflects strong indigenous innovation aligned with national priorities. Notably, Drone Matrx, led by Karnavati University students, and other supported startups represent innovation in SpaceTech, Robotics, and Unmanned Systems, closely aligned with the university's defence-focused initiatives. The support under the scheme of MeitY Startup Hub (MSH) marks a key milestone for student-led innovation. Through the EIR program, KIIF enables founders with grant support, structured mentorship, capacity building, and validation assistance to progress from idea to impact.

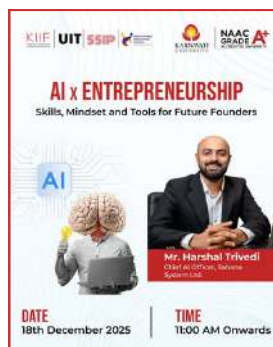

Aarambh 5.0: Nurturing Student Innovations @KIIF

Enabling students to identify real-world problems and develop innovation-driven solutions

As part of Aarambh 5.0, the pre-incubation drive by Karnavati Innovation and Incubation Foundation (KIIF), a series of structured orientation and capacity-building sessions were conducted to support early-stage student innovators. The first session focused on orienting participants to the Aarambh 5.0 program, highlighting its objectives, structure, timelines, and the pre-incubation support available through KIIF. This helped students clearly understand the innovation journey and expectations ahead.

The second session, led by Dr. Srinadh Mattaparthi, centred on the Problem Statement Canvas, sensitising students on identifying real-world problems, understanding user pain points, and framing challenges with clarity and purpose. Designed as an interactive and hands-on engagement, the session enabled students to translate initial ideas into well-defined problem statements.

The sessions saw active participation from 50+ student innovators, reflecting strong enthusiasm for structured innovation and entrepreneurship. Together, these engagements laid a strong foundation for students to progress through the Aarambh 5.0 pre-incubation program and build impactful, viable innovations.
